**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS  
REGARDING REQUESTS FOR REZONING  
AND FOR SPECIAL USE APPROVAL**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, pursuant to Public Act 110 of 2006, as amended, that public hearings will be held by the Frenchtown Charter Township Planning Commission on Thursday, July 21, 2022 at 7:00 p.m., or soon thereafter at Frenchtown Township Hall, 2744 Vivian Road, Monroe, Michigan.

The meeting will also allow participation virtually, using an online video call platform. A link and instructions to join the meeting will be posted on the Township Website, at [www.frenchtowntownship.org](http://www.frenchtowntownship.org) in advance of the meeting.

**THE PURPOSE OF THE FIRST PUBLIC HEARING** is to hear and consider a request to rezone parcels # 58-07-532-038-10, 58-07-018-501-00, and 50-07-018-501-20, 6398 N. Dixie Highway, from A, Agricultural to GM, General Manufacturing District. The three parcels total 33.60 acres more or less and are located along the access road to the Enrico Fermi Nuclear Power Plant.

**THE PURPOSE OF THE SECOND PUBLIC HEARING** is to hear and consider a request for special use approval for development of a private grass airstrip for the use of a single ultralite aircraft, on a 10.11-acre parcel located at 4992 Post Road (Parcel # 58-07-018-511-60). The parcel where the special use is being requested is zoned A, Agricultural.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN**, that information regarding the rezoning and the special use requests may be examined at the Township Hall, 2744 Vivian Road, Monroe, Michigan during regular business hours (M-F 8:30-4:30).
